

Boat Slip Rental GPS Tracking Requirement

On September 15, 2003, the original developer of The Harborage Subdivision entered into an agreement with the United States Department of the Interior and Florida Fish and Wildlife Service, in order to allow a boat marina on the Braden River. This agreement was in compliance with Manatee protection measures in a Restricted Zone along Braden River. The agreement requires a means to track each boat as it leaves the Harborage marina and moves through the Manatee Protection Zone along Braden River and a way to measure the boats speed through the zone. In compliance with that agreement all watercraft/boats originating from the Harborage marina must use an onboard GPS tracking device that tracks both location and speed. This agreement also requires that all Harborage marina boat slip/lift rental agreements state the device is required.

GPS tracking device should be compatible with a LandAirSea 3100 Tracking Device or approved equivalent (tracks movement, speed and location in a downloadable file). Many are now available for mobile devices (smart phones, tablets, etc.).
